

Home Learning Year 1 and 2



Reading

Regular (daily) reading has a huge impact on a child's learning. Children will be sent home with reading books matched to their reading level, however we also encourage children to read anything that interests them (books from home, magazines, newspapers, recipes, ANYTHING). Reading out loud to an adult is particularly beneficial and follow-up discussions are invaluable.



Raz-kids gives you access to hundreds of books with follow-up quizzes. Log on once a week to boost reading comprehension skills.

Maths



Children will sometimes be set a homework task on the MyMaths learning platform. We will inform you when we have set an activity.

Spellings

Children will be taught spellings in school, but it is helpful if this learning is reinforced at home. Children will be sent home with weekly word lists on a Friday for them to practise ready for a quiz in school the following Friday.

Topic

From time-to-time we may send home an enquiry-led activity for your child to explore at home. This will often be discussion-based, but we also celebrate any projects or activities that your child would like to do at home and bring in to share.
